In 2021, around 40% of offenders on bail for domestic abuse-related offences breached their bail conditions, with around 60% of individuals who breached being re-arrested within six months. To keep victims and children safe, and reduce breaches and reoffense, we offer a comprehensive package of support for both those on bail and their victims.

What to expect:

This comprehensive training equips domestic abuse specialists to deliver effective support and intervention to those who are currently on police bail for domestic abuse related crimes. This intervention includes enhanced skills in risk assessment, delivering safety net strategies, and the ability to collaborate effectively with law enforcement and other agencies.

You will:

- Understand 'Engage' – our strategic approach to ending domestic abuse – and how you can implement best practice in your service.
- Learn how to provide bespoke approaches of support based on perpetrator typologies.
- Understand how to manage disguised compliance and denial.
- Strengthen your response skills to victims of domestic abuse using trauma-informed practice and referral pathways.
- Master the fundamentals of legal framework, bail conditions and collaboration with Law Enforcement.
- Gain a comprehensive understanding into dual presentation/counter allegations, and ability to signpost to tools and training.
- Learn how to confidently evaluate the level of risk in domestic abuse scenarios and create effective safety plans.

Suitable for:

For domestic abuse professionals co-locating within custody suites, domestic abuse agencies, other bail support services, probation staff delivering early intervention strategies for domestic abuse to those who harm. Professionals who will be allocated to the victim work as part of the intervention.

Note that specialists working with both cohorts (perpetrators and victims) will be expected to attend the training.
